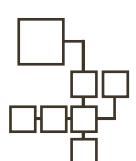
Outdoor conversations about Braco Dimitrijevic's installation

"The Casual Passer-by I met at 3.01 PM, Philadelphia, April 9, 2007"

Join us for four site-specific conversations about "The Casual Passer-by I Met...", a temporary installation on the facade of 4001 Walnut Street. Each location figured in the map above provides a different perspective on the interpretation, curation, and production of the work. These conversations feature the artist, project curators, and community members who have contributed to the realization of the project. Participants are invited to attend multiple conversations; maps and further information are available from the Slought Foundation storefront at 4017 Walnut Street. Dimitrijevic has created *Casual Passer-by* installations in cities around the world, beginning in his native Yugoslavia in 1968. These monumental portraits index the continual changes to our understanding of the public sphere, mirroring the personality cults often associated with celebrities and political leaders, as well as the increasingly mass media saturated urban environment.

Conversants include David Brownlee, Katherine Carl, Laura Heffernan, David Hollenberg and Mark Kocent, Aaron Levy, Jean-Michel Rabaté, and Osvaldo Romberg. Each conversation will be moderated by undergraduate students in the RBSL Bergman Foundation Curatorial Seminar at the University of Pennsylvania.
